AMENDED INTERIM BANKRUPTCY RULE 1007-I GENERAL ORDER NO. 11-2009

Interim Rule 1007-I¹ of the Federal Rules of Bankruptcy Procedure, which the Bankruptcy Court for the Northern District of Georgia adopted in General Order No. 10-2008, was amended on December 1, 2009 coinciding with time computation amendments to Rule 1007 and other Federal Rules of Bankruptcy Procedure, Bankruptcy related statutes and Bankruptcy Forms that took effect on the same date as approved by the Judicial Conference of the United States on September 16, 2008.

The material change is that the 15- day time periods in Bankruptcy Rule 1007-I© have been changed to 14- day periods. By General Order No. 11-2009, entered on December 2, 2009, this Court adopts the time computation changes in Interim Bankruptcy Rule 1007-I.

¹Interim Rule 1007-I takes account of the National Guard and Reservists Debt Relief Act of 2008, Pub. L. No. 110-438 which amended § 707(b)(2)(D) of the Bankruptcy Code to provide temporary exclusion from the bankruptcy means test for certain members of the National Guard and reserve components of the Armed Forces.
